Job Summary

To lead people to a restored relationship with Jesus Christ by overseeing all the details encompassing a worship service, including worship leading, to help people encounter God and connect with others beyond the service.

Church Summary

Role Responsibilities

1. Plan, organize, implement and evaluate a high-quality worship experience and environment on Sunday mornings (currently one service) and occasional events during the week using various elements (music, media, art, testimonies, readings, etc.) to engage and inspire people to worship God.
2. Lead congregation in musical worship.
3. Mentor musicians and worship team leaders, both technically and spiritually.
4. Develop the ministry leaders and volunteer teams necessary for an effective worship service for a church plant.
5. Work closely with the lead pastor to ensure the worship supports the overall mission of the church.
6. Take intentional, appropriate action during and after worship services to make people of all ages feel welcome and wanted.
7. Be involved in the life of the Restoration community.
8. Connect with other worship directors and pastors through the conference and region for support and continued growth.
9. Other duties as assigned by the lead pastor.
