Wednesday Night Format

- 6:00pm leaders meet at the Ministry Center for prayer and planning
- 6:15-6:30pm students are welcome to come early to hang out, talk, and eat snacks
- 6:30pm START
 - Worship Music the night kicks off with some worship music
 - Welcome students are welcomed, Restoration Students news may be shared, students who invite a friend (and their friend) get <u>CANDY!</u>
 - Game/Activity all students play some kind of crazy-awesome game or do an activity together
 - o Open Prayer students and leaders spend some time in prayer
 - <u>Discussion Topic</u> a speaker will spend some time sharing about a student's relevant topic incorporating God's Word, stories, and a meaningful way for students to connect with God and one another
 - Student Groups students split into their grade-based student group (Middle School or High School) and spend the remaining time in discussion with one another
- 8:00pm END
- 8:00-8:15pm students will be picked up by parents/guardians

Confirmation

- Last year, the Confirmation experience equated with the High School group gathering known as *The Journey DC* (Discipleship / Confirmation). Students were given a choice of participating for either Discipleship OR Confirmation, with Confirmation being the same group time experience but incorporating additional/mandatory outside work
- This year, the Confirmation experience should be understood as a Wednesday Night group *extension opportunity*. Students grades 7-12 desiring to be Confirmed would be expected to:

- 1. Name to the Students Director they want to be on the Confirmation track
- 2. have an 80%+ attendance rate in their group, over a course of two years minimum
- 3. complete assignments their group leader assigns to build a Confirmation portfolio (ex: reflection questions, challenge lessons, Scripture memorization, etc.)
- 4. meet with their group leader outside of Wednesday nights on a bi-monthly basis for a check-in time (approximately 30-60 min)
- o 5. have regular conversations with their parents about faith

MIDDLE SCHOOL GROUP (Sunday Mornings)

Purpose

• Students will spend time encountering an awesome God and building relationships through discussing topics related to the Sunday message and doing relevant activities

Basic Description

• Students in grades 6-8 begin Sunday mornings in the worship service. On the 1st and 3rd Sundays of the month, they are dismissed to the café for discussion and activities that complement the Sunday morning message.

Discussion Sheets

- The Students Director will create discussion sheets meant for both the students and their parents. These sheets *may* include Bible verses, discussion ideas, challenges, questions, activities, etc.
- Students are to use these sheets as a tool for learning, conversing, or reflecting
- Parents are to receive these sheets via email for the purpose of bringing the group interaction time into the home. Parents are encouraged to ask their students about the group time (which *may* come from the sheets, but it doesn't have to)
- NOTE: the sheets are *not* the goal of the group but simply an extension of the group's purpose!
