Infant and Toddler Room Teachers

Responsible for providing safe, nurturing, clean, efficient and friendly environment for infants and toddlers of Restoration Kids. Leads lesson or activity, plays with children or directs their play, exhibits Christ-like patience and love and prays for the children. Teacher is expected to arrive 15 minutes before class and makes sure toys get packed up and the room is in good order before leaving.

Grade Room Teacher

Provides a friendly, safe, compassionate environment for children to learn about Jesus while encouraging spiritual growth and development. Responsibilities include reading and understanding the week's lesson ahead of time; leading the lesson for the week; engaging children and facilitating discussion; spending time praying for each child in the class. Teachers are expected to arrive 15 minutes before class begins and help dismiss students to their parents at pickup.

Supply Team

Meet with others one evening a month to help prepare and organize supplies for Sunday mornings. Tasks include counting and sorting materials, cutting, making copies, etc.

Musicians (Open to considering all instruments)

The goal of the musician at Restoration is to use their gift to give use their God-given gift of music to glorify God, and to create an environment to prepare and engage our hearts in worship to Him. Specific responsibilities include being prepared and available for rehearsal on Thursday evenings at 7pm (If you are unable to make this time but still interested, please talk to Matthew Goerd), and being available on Sundays from 8-11am for set-up and rehearsal followed by the worship service.

Producer

The producer is vital to the goal of creating an experience for people to encounter God without distractions on Sunday mornings. The Producer provides continuity and uniformity by seeing how all the component parts of the service result in the whole, final resulting service. There are many details and a lot of communication that takes place for a Sunday morning service. The producer has several tasks including connecting with key people involved in the service to ensure each aspect of the Sunday service plan is carried out with excellence and authenticity.

Communion (Server, Setup)

At least once a month, we remember the sacrifice Christ made for us and what it means for us by partaking in the sacred practice of Communion. To make that happen, we need volunteers to serve the communion, as well as someone to set up the tables and elements.

Special Readings (Communion, Offering, Scripture)

Another way we worship God is through the reading of scripture, poetry or spoken word, and inviting all to participate in our services by explaining why and how we do Communion, Offering, and other special service elements.
